In order to expedite the process, CSP/AEP will handle the transfer of the City facilities and will bill the city for the costs incurred. It has been determined that it in the best interest of the City to waive competitive bidding to allow CSP/AEP to handle the transfer, as this would be the fastest and most cost effective method to meet the PUCO's request.
