

Dear Mr. Gallagher:

The City of Columbus, Transportation Division, has reviewed the request you submitted on behalf of Frazier Development, Inc., regarding their proposed acquisition of that unimproved right-of-way identified as Exchange Drive north of Commerce Square. It is our understanding acquisition of this right-of-way will allow for future commercial development of their adjacent property. Columbus City Council Resolution Number 113X-86 provides for the sale of City owned property. After investigation, it was determined the City has no objections to the sale of this right-of-way subject to the retention of a general utility easement for those utilities currently located within this unimproved right-of-way. Based upon information provided by the Franklin County Auditor the City has estimated a value of \$2,016.00 for this right-of-way.

If your client desires to proceed with the acquisition of the above referenced rights-ofway please have this "Authorization to Proceed" letter signed and dated in the space provided below then returned, within thirty days, to Ms. Patricia A. Austin, P.E., Administrator, Transportation Division, Public Service Department, 109 North Front Street, 3rd Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215, Attention: Mary Lu English.

If your client objects to the estimated value of \$2.016.00 you will need to contact Ms. Donna Hunter in the Development Department to discuss a possible reduction of this Ms. Hunter's address is: City of Columbus, Development Department, Attention Donna Hunter, Administrator, Land Redevelopment Office, 109 North Front Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. For your convenience I have attached a list of valid mitigating factors that the City will consider when reducing right-of-way transfer prices. Please include a copy of any correspondence you send to Ms. Hunter when you return this "authorization to proceed" letter. Unless mitigating factors that directly benefit the Transportation Division can be identified, our Division policy requires that a recommendation to transfer at full price be forwarded from this Division to the Development Department.
