## PARCEL 72-S STORM SEWER EASEMENT PERPETUAL EASEMENT TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN JOYCE AVENUE AND 17<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE IMPROVEMENTS IN THE NAME AND FOR THE USE OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin, City of Columbus and being part of a 0.327 acre tract of land conveyed to Otis E. and Berthelia by deed of record in Official Record 27164A12 of the Recorders office, Franklin County, Ohio and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the northerly right-of-way line of 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue, the true point of beginning, said point being 30.00 feet left of station 245+50.00;

thence N 4°10'30" E a distance of 4.50 feet, said point being 34.50 feet left of station 245+50.00:

thence S 85°49'30" E a distance of 20.00 feet, said point being 34.50 feet left of station 245+70.00:

thence S 4°10'30" W a distance of 4.50 feet, said point being 30.00 feet left of station 245+70.00:


thence N 85°49'30" W a distance of 20.00 feet to the point of beginning.

The above described area is contained within the Franklin County Auditor's Parcel Number 010-108792. Within said boundary is 0.002 acres, more or less,

This description and survey was prepared and reviewed on September 19, 2013 by Robert A. Bosworth, Registered Surveyor #7750.

The basis of bearings in this description is based on GPS observations using the Ohio CORS Network (Ohio South Zone) to determine a grid bearing in the NAD83 (96CORS adjustment) state plane coordinate system. The Columbus, Mount Vernon, and McConnelsville CORS stations were used in determining the grid bearing, and establishing a bearing along the centerline of Joyce Avenue to be S 86°12'13"E (north of 17<sup>th</sup> Avenue).

All stations and offsets are referenced to the centerline of right of way and construction as filled with the City of Columbus and designated as "2768-DR E"
