thence S 4°09'11"W a distance of 20.00 feet, said point being 45.00 feet right of station 64+48+00;


thence N 85°50'49" W a distance of 15.00 feet to the point of beginning.

The above described area is contained within the Franklin County Auditor's Parcel Number 010-126394. Within said boundary is 0.007 acres, more or less,

This description and survey was prepared and reviewed on October 3, 2013 by Robert A. Bosworth, Registered Surveyor #7750.

The basis of bearings in this description is based on GPS observations using the Ohio CORS Network (Ohio South Zone) to determine a grid bearing in the NAD83 (96CORS adjustment) state plane coordinate system. The Columbus, Mount Vernon, and McConnelsville CORS stations were used in determining the grid bearing, and establishing a bearing along the centerline of Joyce Avenue to be S 86°12'13"E (north of 17th Avenue).

All station and offset are referenced to the centerline of right-of-way and construction as filed with the City of Columbus and designated as "2768-DR E".
