Scope of Work

- 1 Schedule and coordinate CJS resources related to ePay and JusticeFiling installation, configuration and training.
- 2 Review Customer host environment to ensure it meets CJS provided specifications.
- 3 Install current production release version of ePay and JusticeFiling software in Customer's Test environment.
- 4 Complete JusticeFiling configuration for Customer.
- 5 Complete ePay configuration for Customer.
- 6 Test baseline functionality of ePay and JusticeFiling applications in Test environment.
- 7 Provide ePay and JusticeFiling Administrator Training.
- 8 Provide JusticeFiling User Training.
- 9 Install current production release version of ePay and JusticeFiling software in Customer's Production environment.
- 10 Provide go-live support.

Notes

- 1 Quotation must be signed and returned with a purchase order to schedule project
- 2 Delivery will be scheduled for the first available date at which CJS and Customer resources are jointly available. Should rescheduling be necessitated for any reason, the next available date at which CJS and Customer resources are both available will be scheduled.
- 3 Professional Services quoted are on a time and materials basis. Actual effort, costs and expenses may be less than those estimated. The actual effort may exceed the estimate, however the cost for the effort is capped and will not exceed the estimated total for the effort. The cost for the expenses may exceed the estimate and will be based upon actual expenses incurred. The parties may by mutual, written agreement, increase the estimated price.
- 4 If project is cancelled prior to completion, all effort and travel-related costs expended through the date of cancellation will be due and payable.
- 5 Payment for License Fee is due upon contract execution.
- 6 First Year Maintenance and Support will begin, and payment will be due upon quote execution.
- 7 Payment term is net 30 days from invoice date.
- 8 CJS will invoice for the Professional Services fees as rendered.
- 9 Travel costs are estimated and actual cost incurred by CJS will be invoiced to, and payable by, the Customer.
- 10 License(s) are subject to the terms and conditions of the active license agreement.

- 11 The license(s) are limited for use during the term of, and coterminate with, the Customer's active CourtView support agreement
- 12 Except as expressly modified here, Support and Maintenance is subject to the terms and conditions of the active support agreement.
- 13 CJS will invoice for prorated maintenance for the current maintenance year at 1/12th of the annual maintenance fee shown on the "Net Software Maintenance" line for each month of Maintenance and Support provided prior to the conclusion of the current maintenance year.
- 14 Customer is responsible for the host environment including all required licenses, hardware, network and third party software components and configuration.
- 15 ePay and JusticeFiling have been developed using generally accepted industry practices and standards and typically will function with most commonly used browsers. CJS has tested, and supports under the Maintenance Agreement, the use of the following browsers for use with eAccess: Microsoft Internet Explorer Version 8 or later, Google Chrome Version 24 or later and Mozilla Firefox Version 3 or later. The browser used, and the platform on which it is run, may effect the presentation of the user interface. Presentation anomalies that do not affect eAccess functionality may occur and are not considered defects. CJS does not test the use of eAccess with other browsers and issues caused by the use of a browser not listed above are not covered within the scope of the Maintenance Agreement.
- 16 Delays caused by Customer site or configuration issues may require rescheduling and/or Change Order for additional services and related travel costs.
- 17 Customer will make available all resources requested by CJS for assistance and approval.
- 18 Items 3.4 (Training Component) and 3.5 may be provided remotely or on-site at CJS' option. All other services are to be provided remotely.
- 19 ePay configuration is limited to the configuration of ePay to support JusticeFiling.
- 20 CJS will install ePay and JusticeFiling in one test and one production environment.
- 21 CJS assumes that Customer will use the PayPal payment gateway integrated with JusticeFiling. Use of any other gateway will require a change order to include the scope, and related fees, for the integration for an alternative gateway.
- 22 CJS assumes that Customer will coordinate with their imaging vendor to provide the capability to ingest the .pdf attached to the eFiling from a network file drop into which JusticeFiling will deposit the attachment.
