The Jackson Pike Wastewater Treatment Plant established a standard service agreement for the diagnosis and repair of the Hoffman Blower #2. Once the teardown and inspection occurred, it was determined that additional parts would be needed for the repair.

Estimated lead time for parts is 8 weeks after receipt of the order to complete the repairs. The repair is estimated at 3 weeks after receipt of the parts.

Modification No. 1 - \$7,770.00 (Pending)

Blower # 1 had been repaired in 2013 and the costs did not go above the \$20,000.00 threshold for legislation. Since it was thought that Blower #2 was in better working order than Blower #1 it was not anticipated that the cost would exceed the \$20,000 standard service agreement that had been established.

BissNuss Inc. is the local manufacturer's representative. They will use all OEM parts, and offers a one (1) year warranty.
