Providing labor and equipment to complete emergency repairs to water mains at various locations within the Columbus Water Distribution System on an as-needed basis.

6. **A narrative timeline for the contract including a beginning date, beginning and ending dates for known phases of the contract and a projected ending date.**

Begin date = NTP in ~90 days

Contract work is required to be completed in a manner acceptable to the City within 730 days from the date that a Notice To Proceed (NTP) is given by the City.

7. **A narrative discussing the economic impact or economic advantages of the project; community outreach or input in the development of the project; and any environmental factors or advantages of the project.**

This contract will provide assistance to our water line maintenance crews in completing water main break repairs in a timely matter should severe weather related breaks exceed our normal maintenance capacities.

8. An estimate of the full cost of the Contract including a separate estimate of any and all phases or proposed future contract modifications.

The bid amount and proposed award amount is \$430,694.00 for Travco Construction, Inc. and \$493,597.50 for John Eramo and Sons, Inc., including a 10% construction contingency amount that will be utilized to fund needed and approved changes in the work. No contract modifications are anticipated at this time; however, construction exigency might later compel modification of this contract, if unforeseen difficulties are encountered.
