

Statement of Intent

After twenty years as a resident of the North Linden area, I feel it is time to be included as a voice to be heard of our diverse community. I have lived on Myrtle Avenue since 1995 in a craftsman bungalow that I have been slowly bringing back from the brink of demolition. In 2000, I acquired the property adjacent to 1617, for which I have solely used to practice my landscaping skills, to be certified this year as an Urban wildlife refuge.

I have seen the North Linden area diminish from a somewhat thriving working class neighborhood, to a broken and disbanded contiguity bordered by other areas that have not suffered as much as North Linden has in the past two decades.

Although I was born in Kentucky, I feel my roots are deep in Ohio as my family moved to the suburbs of Columbus in 1964. Growing up on the east side (Gahanna) I have seen just how much the Columbus area has changed for both good and bad. I went to college late in life and completed my Bachelor and Master's degree at The Ohio State University In the Art and Technology Program, in Applied Robotics in Art practices with a full tuition scholarship for both degrees, finishing my studies in 2004. I followed graduation with some time as an adjunct professor at OSU and Columbus State.

I am a freelance photographer by trade and have several notable clients, of which the *Who's Who* Publishing Company based in Columbus is one, as well as several events that occur in the Short North. It would be a dream of mine to open a studio in North Linden and bring some prosperity back to our area.

For the last several years, I have been in dialogue with our city attorney, Richard Pfieffer, concerning matters of crime, safety and the state of many of the abandoned homes and businesses in North Linden. I understand the process the city must traverse in getting abandoned homes either demolished or repurposed. I understand that the commission serves as a voice between the people and city hall.

In the summer of 2014, I along with a core group of individuals, started the North Linden Community Watch, whose concerns addressed the area bounded by Hudson and Weber on the

South and North and Cleveland and I71 on the East and West. We did not feel that we as a group had any kind of representation to address our need for public safety and a unified voice in other matters at hand. As a group, we have managed to open a dialogue with several individuals who are not only concerned with, but want to help us gain a voice with the issues at hand that plague North Linden. In just a short time, we have had our first Fall Festival which allowed the neighbors from all walks of life come together and express our concerns of the neighborhood and become one voice. I serve as block watch captain for Myrtle Avenue.

As a Commissioner, I would like to be one of the voices heard, that could bring back a certain amount of prosperity and pride to the area. My platform I am most concerned with after public safety and abandoned homes/businesses is one of public health and well being. I would like the neighborhood gardens to work with one another and focus on good nutrition and health by offering a farmers market in North Linden specifically. Much as downtown has the North Market, I see no reason why we could not have something similar. We would start off with markets once or twice a month and see how the evolve. If North Linden can offer something competitive to the Fourth Street Gardens, the summer markets in Clintonville and the West side, we will bring in visitors to the area and show them the options we could potentially offer them.

As an artist that is in touch with not only the baby boomers, but also the millennials, I would like to see North Linden evolve as another viable option where creative individuals can work, play, live and create.

One final note. I am the Social Media Director and Fall Fest Chairman for the North Linden Community Watch. I would love to offer my services to keep the NLAC websites up to date. In the age of technology, I find it extremely important to have a go to resource for individuals to follow.
