The Jackson Pike and Southerly Wastewater Treatment Plants also have security systems that were installed and are now maintained and monitored by SimplexGrinnell is the developer & installer of the security systems and does not allow anyone but their own company employees to work on or make repairs to the systems.

3. Describe efforts to determine/verify that the company is the sole source: The systems were developed and installed by SimplexGrinnell. SimplexGrinnell provides the software and maintenance support and monitoring services for these systems.

4. **Indicate how the price or fee structure was determined:** This contract covers a five-year period from July 1, 2013 through and including June 30, 2018. For each year of the five year contract, funds for the services shall be reviewed and expenditures approved by Ordinance. The current year's agreement is for the period of July 1, 2015 through and including June 30, 2016. Quote dated March 3, 2015 is for up to 16 hours of Technical Labor to assist in loading new access cards for the Sewer Maintenance Operations Center locations of 1250 Fairwood Avenue and 1388 Emig Road. Quotes dated May 21, 2015 are for the yearly costs for 2015-2016. This modification will include a lump sum amount of \$10,000.00 that is to set up a contingency fund to be used as necessary if there is a repair identified outside of the service agreement.
