This project will run a 288 strand fiber optic cable from the Communications Tower at the Parsons Avenue Water Treatment Plant to the Administration Building at the Southerly Wastewater Treatment Plant. From the Administration Building, a 24 strand fiber optic cable will be installed to the Division of Power substation located at the Southerly Wastewater Treatment Plant. An additional 288 strand fiber optic cable will be installed between the Administration Building at the Southerly Wastewater Treatment Plant and the Administration Building at the Southwesterly Composting Facility.

This project will connect the substation, the Southerly Wastewater Treatment Plant, and the Southwesterly Composting Facility to the City of Columbus MetroNet system. It will provide internet services to these facilities and will remove the need for a contracted internet system.

The bid amount and proposed award amount is \$286,155.46, including a 20% construction contingency amount that will be utilized to fund needed and approved changes in the work.
