The companies responded to a Request for Proposal (RFP), SA-006151, and were selected by an evaluation committee as the companies with the best proposals based on price, prior experience, resources and qualifications.

The contractors have a proven track record, experience, and understanding of the requirements of the Land Bank program. A total of eighteen companies responded.
