- 2. Detailed explanation of reason (must be completed by division): Last year, McKay Lodge was selected to restore/repair the Firefighter's Memorial following an open bid/RFP process. McKay Lodge was one of two firms responding, the other was located in California. To date, McKay Lodge has successfully completed each project contracted by the City of Columbus and the Columbus Museum of Art (Rod L. Bouc, Deputy Executive Director of Operations & Chief Registrar participates in proposal review). After the legislation passed, Development staff became aware of plans to redevelop the memorial area to better fit in with the Scioto Mile redevelopment and create a more contemplative place of remembrance. For aesthetic and safety reasons, Development was asked to add the relocation of the gas line and regulator to the eternal flame to the restoration project. Development requested McKay Lodge's Conservator of Stone, evaluate this request and it was advised that the work to relocate the gas line and regulator be completed at the same time as the planned restoration to the monument. Doing so would be economical, efficient and less disruptive to the memorial. Because the City was already in contract with McKay Lodge, we are requesting funds and authorization to contract with McKay Lodge to also relocate the gas line and regulator.
