Damopoulos by deeds recorded in Instrument Numbers 200507130137875 and 200507250146726 (all references to deeds, microfiche, plats, surveys, etc. refer to the records of the Franklin County Recorder's Office, unless noted otherwise), and being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a 1" iron pipe found at the northwest corner of said Lot No. 22, being at the intersection of the south right of way line of Mound Street (50' public right of way, originally dedicated as Dartmoor Road, see City of Columbus Ordinance No. 196-43) with the east right of way line of Roys Avenue (50' public right of way);

thence along the north line of said Lot No. 22 and the south right of way line of said Mound Street, South eighty-one degrees forty-five minutes fifty-nine seconds East (S81°45'59"E) for sixteen and 18/100 feet (16.18');

thence leaving said lines across said Lot No. 22, South twelve degrees fifty minutes one second West (S12°50'01"W) for thirty and 49/100 feet (30.49');

thence continuing across said Lot No. 22, North seventy-seven degrees nine minutes fifty-nine seconds West (N77°09'59"W) for sixteen and 13/100 feet (16.13') to the west line of said Lot No. 22 and the east right of way line of said Roys Avenue;

thence along said lines, North twelve degrees fifty minutes one second East (N12°50'01"E) for twenty-nine and 19/100 feet (29.19') to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**, containing 0.0110 acres (481.2 S.F.), more or less, subject however to all covenants, conditions, restrictions, reservations and easements contained in any instrument of record pertaining to the above described tract of land.

Bearings are based upon the Ohio State Plane Coordinate System, South Zone, NAD83 (2007). Said bearings originated from said coordinate system by GPS observations and observations of Franklin County Survey Monuments 5/14 and COC 1-83. The portion of the centerline of Mound Street stretching west to east from Binns Boulevard to Ogden Avenue, having a bearing of S81°45′59″E, is designated the "Basis of Bearing" for this description.
