Winkler and Bruce Winkler by deed recorded in Instrument No. 200403010043826 (all references to deeds, microfiche, plats, surveys, etc. refer to the records of the Franklin County Recorder's Office, unless noted otherwise) and being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a 1" iron pin found at the northeast corner of said Lot No. 1, being at the intersection of the south right of way line of Mound Street (50' public right of way, originally dedicated as Dartmoor Road, see City of Columbus Ordinance No. 196-43) with the west right of way line of Warren Avenue (50' public right of way);

thence along the east line of said Lot No. 1 and the west right of way line of said Warren Avenue, South eight degrees fourteen minutes one second West (S08°14'01"W) for ten and 10/100 feet (10.10') to an iron pin set;

thence leaving said lines across said Lot No. 1, North thirty-six degrees twenty-eight minutes fifty seconds West (N36°28'50"W) for fourteen and 21/100 feet (14.21') to an iron pin set on the north line of said Lot No. 1 and the south right of way line of said Mound Street;

thence along said lines, South eighty-one degrees forty-five minutes fifty-nine seconds East (S81°45'59"E) for ten and 00/100 feet (10.00') to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**, containing 0.0012 acres (50.5 S.F.), more or less, subject however to all covenants, conditions, restrictions, reservations and easements contained in any instrument of record pertaining to the above described tract of land.

Iron pins set are 5/8" rebar, 30" in length, with a plastic plug placed on top inscribed with the name "WOOLPERT INC", unless otherwise noted. All monuments found are in good condition unless otherwise noted.

Bearings are based upon the Ohio State Plane Coordinate System, South Zone, NAD83 (2007). Said bearings originated from said coordinate system by GPS observations and observations of Franklin County Survey Monuments 5/14 and COC 1-83. The portion of the centerline of Mound Street stretching west to east from Binns Boulevard to Ogden Avenue, having a bearing of S81°45′59″E, is designated the "Basis of Bearing" for this description.

This description was prepared under the direction of Cody Schneider, Ohio Registered Surveyor No. 8670, of Woolpert Inc., and is based on a field survey performed during February and March, 2013, as well as February, 2016.
