Situate in the City of Columbus, County of Franklin, State of Ohio, Virginia Military Survey No. 971, being part of Lot No. 418 of Westland Addition Extension No. 1 Subdivision as recorded in Plat Book 17, Page 202 and conveyed to Robert Andrew Elswick by deed recorded in Deed Volume 3547, Page 867 (all references to deeds, microfiche, plats, surveys, etc. refer to the records of the Franklin County Recorder's Office, unless noted otherwise) and being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

**BEGINNING** at a drill hole set at the southeast corner of said Lot No. 418, being at the intersection of the north right of way line of Mound Street (50' public right of way, originally dedicated as Dartmoor Road, see City of Columbus Ordinance No. 196-43) with the west right of way line of Richardson Avenue (50' public right of way);

thence along the south line of said Lot No. 418 and the north right of way line of said Mound Street, North seventy-six degrees forty-five minutes fifty-seven seconds West (N76°45'57"W) for ten and 00/100 feet (10.00') to an iron pin set;

thence leaving said lines across said Lot No. 418, North fifty-eight degrees two minutes three seconds East (N58°02'03"E) for fourteen and 9/100 feet (14.09') to an iron pin set on the east line of said Lot No. 418 and the west right of way line of said Richardson Avenue;

thence along said lines, South twelve degrees fifty minutes three seconds West (S12°50'03"W) for ten and 00/100 feet (10.00') to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**, containing 0.0011 acres (50.0 S.F.), more or less, subject however to all covenants, conditions, restrictions, reservations and easements contained in any instrument of record pertaining to the above described tract of land.

Iron pins set are 5/8" rebar, 30" in length, with a plastic plug placed on top inscribed with the name "WOOLPERT INC", unless otherwise noted. All monuments found are in good condition unless otherwise noted.

Bearings are based upon the Ohio State Plane Coordinate System, South Zone, NAD83 (2007). Said bearings originated from said coordinate system by GPS observations and observations of Franklin County Survey Monuments 5/14 and COC 1-83. The portion of the centerline of Mound Street stretching west to east from Binns Boulevard to Ogden Avenue, having a bearing of S81°45′59″E, is designated the "Basis of Bearing" for this description.
