[Surveyor's description of the premises follows]

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Delaware, City of Columbus, located in Farm Lot 11 of Quarter Township 4, Township 3 North, Range 18 West, of the United States Military Lands, being part of the 2.135 acre tract known as The Village at Worthington Crossing Condominiums (Deed Book 623, Page 210) by **The Village at Worthington Crossing Condominiums Association** (Grantor) in Deed Book 623, Page 210 and being described as follows:

Being a parcel of land lying north of and adjacent to the north existing right-of-way line of Lazelle Road, as described in Deed Book 576, Page 669 more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a monument found (FCGS 0015) at the centerline of existing right-of-way of Lazelle Road, being station 143+42.78;

Thence South 86°37'39" East, along the centerline of existing right-of-way of Lazelle Road, a distance of 131.47 feet to a point on said centerline, being at centerline station 144+74.25;

Thence leaving said centerline at right angles North $03^{\circ}22'21''$ East, a distance of 50.00 feet to a point on the north right-of-way line of Lazelle Road, being 50.00 feet left of centerline station 144+74.25, and being the **Point of Beginning** for the herein described temporary parcel;

Thence through said The Village at Worthington Crossing Condominiums Association – Phase I tract (2.135 acres), North 87°18'38" East, a distance of 47.36 feet to a point, being 55.00 feet left of centerline station 145+21.35;

Thence continuing through said The Village at Worthington Crossing Condominiums Association – Phase I tract (2.135 acres), parallel to and 55.00 feet left of the centerline of right-of-way of Lazelle Road South 86°37'39" East, a distance of 77.34 feet to a point, being 55.00 feet left of centerline station 145+98.69;

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Thence continuing through said The Village at Worthington Crossing Condominiums Association – Phase I tract (2.135 acres), South $82^{\circ}40'32''$ East, a distance of 72.57 feet to a point on the north right-of-way line of Lazelle Road, being 50.00 feet left of centerline station 146+71.09;

Thence along said north right-of-way line of Lazelle Road being the south property line of The Village at Worthington Crossing Condominiums Association – Phase I tract (2.135 acres), North 86°37'39" West, a distance of 196.83 feet to the **Point of Beginning**.

Containing 0.016 acre (686 square feet), more or less, out of The Village at Worthington Crossing Condominiums (Deed Book 623, Page 210) by The Village at Worthington Crossing Condominiums Association.

All references herein are to records in the Recorders' Office of Delaware County, Ohio.

The basis of bearings for this description is based on the bearing of South 86°25'36" East for the centerline of Lazelle Road as established by the Franklin County Engineers office between monuments "FCGS 2225" and "FCGS 2226" as shown in right of way plan FRA-LAZELLE ROAD-PHASE A on file with the City of Columbus, Ohio.

All pins set are 3/4 inch rebar, 30 inches long, with a plastic cap stamped "CEC, INC.".

All stations and offsets referred to herein are measured from the centerline of existing right-ofway of Lazelle Road as shown upon the right of way plan FRA-LAZELLE ROAD-PHASE C on file with the City of Columbus, Ohio.

This description was prepared under the direction of Daniel J. Hornyak, Registered Professional Surveyor Number 7963, and based upon a field survey of property monumentation found, the centerline of existing roadway, and recorded deed descriptions and plats. The said survey was performed by Columbus Engineering Consultants, Inc., and is not a complete boundary survey of properties involved in the development of the right-of-way plans known as FRA-LAZELLE ROAD-PHASE C.
