## **0.100 ACRE**

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin, City of Columbus, lying in Survey Number 3453 of the Virginia Military District, being part of the 120.07 acre tract known as Segment F (Line Code 8122) conveyed to New York Central Lines, LLC by deed of record in Instrument Number 200212180325201, now known as CSX Transportation Inc., successor by merger of record in Instrument Number 200507210144733 and Instrument Number 200507210144738, as originally conveyed to the Toledo & Ohio Central Railway Company by deed of record in Deed Book 250, Page 387 (all references are to the records of the Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio) and being more particularly described as follows:

**BEGINNING, FOR REFERENCE**, at Franklin County Geodetic Survey monument number 8855 found marking an angle point in the centerline of Avery Road and on an easterly line of a remainder of the 139.874 acre tract conveyed to Homewood Corporation by deed of record in Official Record 23250A17, also located on the line between said Survey Number 3453 and Survey Number 3012 of the Virginia Military District;

thence South 05° 27' 44" East, with said centerline, said easterly line, and said Survey line, a distance of 85.07 feet, to a magnetic nail set at a southeasterly corner thereof and the northeasterly corner of the 5.298 acre tract conveyed to W. Heath Elliott and Stacy E. Elliott by deed of record in Instrument Number 199812290335107;

thence South 83° 28' 01" West, with a southerly line of said 139.874 acre remainder tract, the southerly line of Lot 2 as shown on the plat entitled "Avondale Senior Village Amended" of record in Plat Book 114, Pages 41-43, also being the southerly line of the 7.110 acre tract conveyed to Columbus Metropolitan Housing Authority by deed of record in Instrument Number 201106230078694, the southerly line of a remainder of said 139.874 acre tract, and the northerly line of said 5.298 acre tract (passing iron pins previously set by EMH&T for said "Avondale Senior Village Amended" at 80.01 feet and 813.88 feet and a magnetic nail previously set at 30.00 feet), a distance of 1321.66 feet, to an iron pin set at the northwesterly corner of said 5.298 acre tract, being the *True Point of Beginning*;

thence South 05° 27' 47" East, with the westerly line of said 5.298 acre tract, a distance of 114.84 feet, to an iron pin set at a southwesterly corner thereof;

thence North 39° 16' 46" West, across said 120.07 acre tract, a distance of 136.51 feet, to an iron pin set at the southwesterly corner of the remainder of said 139.874 acre tract;

thence North 83° 28' 01" East, with the southerly line of a remainder of said 139.874 acre tract, a distance of 75.99 feet, to the *True Point of Beginning*, containing 0.100 acre, more or less.

Subject, however, to all legal rights-of-way and/or easements, if any, of previous record.

Iron pins set, where indicated, are iron pipes, thirteen sixteenths (13/16) inch inside diameter, thirty (30) inches long with a plastic plug placed in the top bearing the initials EMHT INC.

The bearings shown hereon were transferred from a field traverse originating from and tying to Franklin County Survey Control Monuments, including FCGS 8876 and FCGS 2221, and are based on the Ohio State Plane Coordinate System, South Zone as per NAD 83, 1986 Adjustment, having a calculated bearing of North 88° 53' 20" East.
