EXPLANATION OF LEGISLATION					
Background: This ordinance will grant permission to the following group to apply for temporary liquor permits authorizing the sale and sampling of wine at a special event to be held during 2017: 1) SID Public Services Association for the Pearl Market, Tuesdays and Fridays, June 2 – October 20. This organization wishes to sell and provide wine sampling to eligible patrons on city streets and city property to be used for the event. This is the first year for closing a public street to hold the event to conduct wine sampling and sales. In 2016 the Ohio General Assembly passed a law that allows Ohio wineries without a distributor to direct market/sell at farmers markets. The City of Columbus, acting by and through its Director of Recreation and Parks, is required to grant approval to the organizer of this event so they may obtain the required permits from the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of Liquor Control.
