## Chapter 573 - MOBILE FOOD VENDING

573.161 - Licensed public right-of-way food truck industry representatives.

- (a) The director of public safety shall conduct an annual election among the licensed food truck industry for the public right-of-way food truck industry representatives. Licensed food truck owners who only operate on private property shall not be eligible to vote on the public right-of-way food truck industry representative or to serve as the public right-of-way food truck industry representative.
- (b) Nominations will be by petition bearing the name of the licensed public right-of-way food truck industry owner and the signatures of not less than five (5) percent of the licensed public right-of-way food truck owners, determined as of December 1.
- (c) Each licensed public right-of-way food truck industry owner will be allowed two (2) votes, to be cast in person, according to such rules and procedures as the director shall establish.
- (d) The election shall be conducted in December and the candidates shall be notified of the results on or before the first Monday in January. The public right-of-way food truck industry owners that receive the highest two (2) vote totals shall be selected as the public right-of-way food truck industry representatives.
- (e) If no petitions are received bearing the valid signatures of at least five (5) percent of the licensed public right-of-way food truck industry owners, the board shall, subject to appointment by the mayor, select the public right-of-way food truck industry representatives from among the licensed public right-of-way food truck industry.
- (f) In the event of a tie vote, the mayor shall select which of those tied shall serve on the board.
- 573.162 Licensed private property food truck industry representatives.
- (a) The director shall conduct an annual election among the licensed food truck industry for the private property food truck industry representatives. Licensed food truck owners who operate in the public right-of-way shall not be eligible to vote on the private property food truck industry representative or to serve as the private property food truck industry representative.
- (b) Nominations will be by petition bearing the name of the licensed private property food truck industry owner and the signatures of not less than five (5) percent of the licensed private property food truck owners, determined as of December 1.

- (c) Each licensed private property food truck industry owner will be allowed two (2) votes, to be cast in person, according to such rules and procedures as the director shall establish.
- (d) The election shall be conducted in December and the candidates shall be notified of the results on or before the first Monday in January. The private property food truck industry owners that receive the highest two (2) vote totals shall be selected as the private property food truck industry representatives.
- (e) If no petitions are received bearing the valid signatures of at least five (5) percent of the licensed private property food truck industry owners, the board shall, subject to appointment by the mayor, select the private property food truck industry representatives from among the licensed public right-of-way food truck industry.
- (f) In the event of a tie vote, the mayor shall select which of those tied shall serve on the board.
- 573.163 Licensed pushcart representatives.
- (a) The director shall conduct an <del>annual</del> election among the licensed pushcart industry for the pushcart representatives.
- (b) Nominations will be by petition bearing the name of the licensed pushcart owner and the signatures of not less than five (5) percent of the licensed pushcart owners, determined as of December 1.
- (c) Each licensed pushcart owner will be allowed two (2) votes, to be cast in person, according to such rules and procedures as the director shall establish.
- (d) The election shall be conducted in December and the candidates shall be notified of the results on or before the first Monday in January. The pushcart owners that receive the highest two (2) vote totals shall be selected as the pushcart representatives.
- (e) If no petitions are received bearing the valid signatures of at least five (5) percent of the licensed public right-of-way food truck industry owners, the board shall, subject to appointment by the mayor, select the pushcart representatives from among the licensed pushcarts.
- (f) In the event of a tie vote, the mayor shall select which of those tied shall serve on the board.

573.164 - Notification of board member selections.

On or before the first Monday in January of each year, nNotice of the selection of board members shall be given to the director of public safety as follows:

- (a) The License Section shall submit the names of elected representatives by means of a letter;
- (b) The mayor shall submit the names of the six (6) members which were appointed as provided in Section 573.16 by means of a letter; and
- (c) The mayor shall announce his tie breaking selection if necessary as provided in Sections 573.161, 573.162, and 573.163.

573.166 - Board members' terms; compensation.

The City representatives shall serve during their incumbency. All other members shall serve for a term of  $\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{2}$ 

## Chapter 585 - VEHICLE FOR HIRE BOARD

585.04 - Licensed taxicab, livery, and transportation network driver member

The Director shall conduct an <del>annual</del> election among the licensed taxicab, livery, and transportation network company drivers for a representative from each of the classes of drivers as given in Section 585.03. Nominations will be by petition bearing the name of the licensed driver and the signatures of not less than five percent (5%) of the drivers in each class, determined as <del>of December 1</del> <u>needed</u>.

Each licensed driver will be allowed one (1) vote, to be cast in person, to be counted only in the class of driver to which the driver is determined, according to such rules and procedures as the Director shall establish. The election shall be conducted in December as needed and each of the candidates shall be notified of the results on or before the first Monday in January. The drivers shall each be selected by a majority of the votes cast in each class. If no petitions are received bearing the valid signatures of at least five percent (5%) of the drivers in each class of drivers, the Board shall, subject to the appointment by the Mayor, select the driver member from among the licensed drivers in the appropriate class.

585.05 - Licensed vehicle for hire owner member.

The Director shall conduct an <del>annual</del> election among the licensed vehicle for hire owners for a representative from each of the classes of owners as given in Section 585.03. Nominations will be by petition bearing the name of the licensed vehicle owner and the signatures of not less than five (5) percent of the owners in each class of owners<del>, determined as of December 1</del>.

Each licensed owner will be allowed one (1) vote, to be cast in person, to be counted only in the class of owner to which the owner is determined, according to such rules and procedures as the Director shall establish. The election shall be conducted in December as needed and each of the candidates shall be notified of the results on or before the first Monday in January. The owners shall each be selected by a majority of the votes cast in each class. If no petitions are received bearing the valid signatures of at least five (5) percent of the owners in each class of owners, the Board shall, subject to the appointment by the Mayor, select the vehicle for hire owner member from among the licensed vehicle for hire owners in the appropriate class.

## 585.051 - Licensed transportation network company member

The Director shall conduct an annual election among the licensed transportation network companies for a representative as given in Section 585.03. Nominations will be by petition bearing the name of the licensed transportation network company and the signatures of not less than five percent (5%) of the companies, determined as of December 1.

Each licensed transportation network company will be allowed one (1) vote, to be cast in person, according to such rules and procedures as the Director shall establish. The election shall be conducted in December as needed and each of the candidates shall be notified of the results on or before the first Monday in January. The company shall be selected by a majority vote. If no petitions are received bearing the valid signatures of at least five percent (5%) of the companies, the Board shall, subject to the appointment by the Mayor, select the transportation network company member from among the licensed transportation network companies.

## 585.06 - Notification of Board member selections.

On or before the first Monday in January of each year, nNotice of the selection of board members shall be given to the Director as follows:

- (a) The License Section shall submit the names of elected representatives by means of a letter;
- (b) The Mayor shall submit the names of the six (6) members which were appointed as provided in Section 585.03 by means of a letter; and
- (c) The Mayor shall announce any tie breaking selection(s) as provided in Section 585.03 by means of a letter.

585.12 - Board members' terms; compensation.

The Director and the City Auditor shall serve during the Director's and City Auditor's incumbency. The chairperson of the public safety committee of City Council shall serve as long as he or she holds this position on City Council. All other members shall serve for a term of  $\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{2}$
