The work includes furnishing Construction Administration / Inspection services for projects commencing during the 2017 - 2019 fiscal years for Division of Sewerage and Drainage, Division of Water, Division of Power, and the Department of Finance and Management projects.

The work includes full-time or part-time Construction Administration Services including resident project inspection for any specific project identified. In general, the Consultant will respond to the Contractor's requests for information, respond to inquiries regarding the interpretation of the contract documents, review Contractors claims for additional services and costs, review quality or materials/equipment substitutions and provide recommendations to the City, coordinate project submittals, schedule and chair progress meetings, and other services as directed by the City.
