The goal of this project is to replace the existing 6-inch and 8-inch water lines that have a high break frequency. Replacement of these lines will improve water service, decrease burden on water maintenance operations, and reduce water loss.

The project will include approximately 17,400 linear feet of water line replacement. The existing water mains range from 70 to 88 years in age and from 6-inches to 8-inches in diameter. Along with the installation of new 8-inch water mains, the project will also include new fire hydrant installations and water service transfers.

Planning Area - "North Linden"; the majority of the project is located between Karl Road and Cleveland Avenue, bounded by Huy Road to the south and Ward Road to the north.
