SUBJECT:

General Fund Financial Impact of Tentative IAFF Contract (2017-2020)

Negotiations between the City of Columbus and the International Association of Fire Fighters (IAFF) Local #67, which represents approximately 1,580 uniformed employees paid out of the general fund, have resulted in a successor agreement. The predecessor collective bargaining agreement expired on November, 1, 2017 and the successor agreement will be effective through October 31, 2020.

Across the board wage increases of 3.25%, 3.25%, and 3.5% will be effective with the pay periods that include November 1st of 2017 (retroactively), 2018, and 2019 respectively, resulting in an aggregate cost to the general fund of approximately \$35.2 million over the three year term. Costs associated with health insurance coverage were addressed through increases in the employee's share of health insurance premiums, increases in deductibles and out-of-pocket maximums, and other changes to the plan designs of medical and prescription drug insurance coverages. All new employees hired on or after January 1, 2019 will contribute 20% of medical insurance premiums.
