The work includes furnishing Construction Administration / Inspection services for the 2017 – 2019 fiscal years for Division of Sewerage and Drainage, Division of Water Division of Power, and the Department of Finance and Management projects.

The work includes full-time or part-time Construction Administration Services including resident project inspection for any specific project identified. In general, the Consultant will respond to the Contractor's requests for information, respond to inquiries regarding the interpretation of the contract documents, review Contractors claims for additional services and costs, review quality or materials/equipment substitutions and provide recommendations to the City, coordinate project submittals, schedule and chair progress meetings, and other services as directed by the City.

The original agreement included services for two Division of Water projects: Maize Road Area Water Line Improvements (including 8<sup>th</sup> Ave. WL Imp's) (690236-100071 & 690236-100108, Contract 2048) and General Construction (690549-100000).

- Renewal No. 1 included services for the Division of Water's O'Shaughnessy Dam 2018 Spillway Erosion Rehabilitation Project (690472-100002, Contract 2182).
- Renewal No. 2 includes services for the Division of Water's Dundee Avenue Area Water Line Improvements Project (690236-100082, Contract No. 2057).
- Renewal No. 3 (current) includes services for the Division of Water's Dresden St. Area Water Line Improvements Project (690236-100090, Contract No. 2114).

The Dresden St. Community Planning Areas include "South Linden (45)" (majority), "Milo-Grogan (48)", and "Northeast (41)".

\*Future modifications are anticipated, but unknown at this time.

This is a three-year agreement from 2017 through 2019. The specific duration of services on each project are negotiated between the contracting agency and the consultant. The Dresden Street Area Water Line Improvements Project is 365 calendar days.

The Division of Water does not have the manpower to perform all of the duties necessary to administer and inspect construction of said projects; Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. will perform the services.

The goal of the Dresden Street Area Water Line Improvements Project is to replace or rehabilitate the existing 6-inch, 8-inch, and 12-inch water lines that have a high break frequency, which will improve water service, decrease burden on water maintenance operations, and reduce water loss. The Neighborhood Liaison has been contacted and informed of this project.
