WHEREAS, the City of Columbus is the owner of the alley south of East Seventeenth, from Rang Avenue to the terminus thereof; and

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners, Tressie D. and Naomi Sermon, Lamb Investment Company, Gus J. and Rita A. Flichia, Property Developers, Jozef Miller & Son Plumbing, Inc. and A-Ultimate Bus Tours & Charters, Inc., an Ohio corporation, desire to acquire said alley; and

WHEREAS, after investigation, it has been determined this is excess right-of-way which the City will sell; and

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WHEREAS, a general utility easement in, on, over, across and through said alley must be retained for the benefit of existing utilities; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Law, Real Estate Division, has determined a total value of \$12,500.00 for said alley; and

WHEREAS, the Land Review Commission has voted to recommend the sale of said alley for the values determined by the Real Estate Division; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in that it is immediately necessary to authorize the Director of the Department of Public Service to execute those documents necessary to sell said alley for the preservation of the public health, peace, property, safety and welfare; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS:

SECTION 1. That the Director of the Department of Public Service be and hereby is authorized to execute those documents prepared by the Department of Law, Real Estate Division, necessary to transfer the following described excess right-of-way to Tressie D. and Naomi Sermon, for \$3,200.00, to-wit:

Being situated in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin, City of Columbus and being the southerly 10 ft. of an unimproved 20 ft. alley adjacent to the northerly line of Lots 1 thru 8, Block K, as shown on the Recorded Subdivision Plat of the Elmhurst Addition (P.B. 11, Pg. 19), and containing 3200 square feet, more or less.

Subject to all road records and easements of record.

SECTION 2. That the Director of the Department of Public Service be and hereby is authorized to execute those documents, prepared by the Department of Law, Real Estate Division, necessary to transfer the following described excess right-of-way to Lamb Investment Company, for \$800.00, to-wit:

Being situated in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin, City of Columbus and being the northerly 10 ft. of a 20 ft. unimproved alley adjacent to Lots 16 and 17, Block K, as shown on the Recorded Subdivision Plat of the Elmhurst Addition (P.B. 11, Pg. 19), and containing 800 square feet, more or less.

Subject to all road records and easements of record.

Being situated in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin1 City of Columbus and being the northerly 10 ft. of a 20 ft. unimproved alley adjacent to Lots 18 and 19, Block K, as shown on the Recorded Subdivision Plat of the Elmhurst Addition (P.S. 11, Pg. 19), and containing 800 square feet, more or less.

Subject to all road records and easements of record.

Being situated in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin, City of Columbus and being the northerly 10 ft. of a 20 ft. unimproved alley adjacent to Lots 20 thru 27, Block K, as shown on the Recorded Subdivision Plat of the Elmhurst Addition (P.B. 11, Pg. 19), and containing 3260 square feet, more or less.

#### TRACT 2

Being situated in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin, City of Columbus and being the southerly 10 ft. of an unimproved 20' alley adjacent to Lot 12, Block K, as shown on the Recorded Subdivision Plat of the Elmhurst Addition (P.S. 11, Pg. 19), and containing 460 square feet, more or less.

Subject to all road records and easements of record.

SECTION 5. That the Director of the Department of Public Service be and hereby is authorized to execute those documents prepared by the Department of Law, Real Estate Division, necessary to transfer the following described excess right-of-way to Jozef Miller & Son Plumbing, Inc., for \$1,200.00, to-wit:

Being situated in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin, City of Columbus and being the southerly 10 ft. of a 20 ft. unimproved alley adjacent to Lots 9 thru 11, Block K, as shown on the Recorded Subdivision Plat of the Elmhurst Addition (P.B. 11, Pg. 19), and containing 1200 square feet, more or less.

Subject to all road records and easements of record.

SECTION 6. That the Director of the Department of Public Service be and hereby is authorized to execute those documents, prepared by the Department of Law, Real Estate Division, necessary to transfer the following described excess right-of-way to A-Ultimate Bus Tours and Charters, Inc., for \$2,780.00, to-wit:

Being situated in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin, City of Columbus and being all of a 20 ft. unimproved alley adjacent to Lots 13, 14, 15, 28, 29 and 30, Block K, as shown on the Recorded Subdivision Plat of the Elmhurst Addition (P.S. 11, Pg. 19), and containing 2784 square feet, more or less.

Subject to all road records and easements of record.

SECTION 7. That a general utility easement in, on, over, across and through the excess right-of-way described in the above sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 be and hereby is retained by the City of Columbus.

SECTION 8. That this Council finds it is in the best interest of the City of Columbus to allow these transfers to

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proceed without requiring competitive bidding and hereby waives the competitive bidding provisions of Columbus City Code (Revised) 1959, Section 329.25, with regard to these transfers.

SECTION 9. That the \$12,500.00, to be received by the City as consideration for these transfers, be deposited in Fund 07-248, Project 248650, Index Code 642678.

SECTION 10. That for the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after passage and approval by the Mayor or ten days after passage if the Mayor neither approves nor vetoes the same.
