Dear Dr. Regan:

The STI, HIV, HCV Interventions and Treatment Section has reviewed your program's workplan and budget and has requested that you expand grant activities to include an additional disease intervention specialist (DIS). Program recognizes the impact on Columbus Public Health (CPH) to be responsive to two (2) state prison reception centers and is increasing the award to allow for an additional DIS position. This additional position will be able to assist with the demand of interviewing the HIV and Syphilis cases that are diagnosed upon entering the reception centers.

CPH will receive an increase of \$52,000 to your STD Control (ST) grant award. CPH must submit a budget revision based on \$301,354.08 in total award, and the revision must be submitted no later than **Monday**, **June 17, 2019** by 4:00 p.m. via the Grants Management Information System 2.0 and in accordance with the Ohio Department of Health's (ODH) Grants Administration Policies and Procedures (OGAPP). Please note that failure to meet the budget revision deadline will result in loss of these funds. No appeals will be accepted.

Your agency will receive a revised Notice of Award after the budget revision is approved by ODH. Since this budget revision is required by ODH to adjust your grant award, it will not count against the number of budget revisions (3) allowable this fiscal year.
