The Rev. Nancy Day-Achauer is the Pastor of Maynard Ave. United Methodist Church. She is also the former Chair of the Westland Area Business Association (WABA). As former Chair of WABA, she organized the Westland Independence Day Parade and Discover Westland, an annual business expo and food tasting event started in 2015 to promote businesses and organizations in Westland. In October 2015 she founded the United Westside Coalition, a group of community partners from Westland and the Hilltop working together to revitalize the Westside.

Pastor Nancy is also a founding member of the Prairie Township Community Health Action Team (CHAT), a group of township community partners focused on improving health and wellbeing in the community. Pastor Nancy works at CHAT's free produce market every month which provides fresh food for low-income families and individuals.
