D E E D O F E A S E M E N T

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Forest H. Thorpe and Emma M. Thorpe, his wife, of the City of Columbus, County of Franklin and State of Ohio, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations to them paid by the City of Columbus, Ohio, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do grant and release to the City of Columbus, Ohio, the its successors and assigns forever, a right of way over and through the following real estate in said City, and described as follows:

Being a strip of land 10 feet in width across the Grantors' property, said property being known as a 1.54a tract located on the west side of Edgell Road, the south line of said tract being about 290 feet north of the north line of Third Avenue, as recorded in Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio, the center line of said strip being described as follows:

Beginning at a manhole in Edgell Road which is approximately 583 feet north of the north line of Third Avenue (said manhole is known as M. N. #59 on City of Columbus Sewer Record Plan No. 926); thence in a southwesterly direction on a line, a distance of 135 feet to a point which is approximately 524 feet north of the north line of Third Avenue; thence westerly on a line which is parallel to the south line of the Grantors' property, a distance of 100 feet,

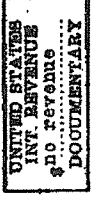
for the purpose of constructing and maintaining an eight inch sewer in any part of said tract including the right to clean, repair and care for said sewer, together with the right of access to said tract for said purpose.

To have and to hold said premises to said Grantee, its successors and assigns if ever, for the uses and purposes hereinbefore mentioned.
