## PARCEL 2-LA FRA-70-12.68 <br> PERPETUAL EASEMENT FOR HIGHWAY PURPOSES INCLUDING LIMITATION OF ACCESS

An exclusive perpetual easement for public highway and road purposes, including, but not limited to any utility construction, relocation and/or utility maintenance work deemed appropriate by the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation, its successors and assigns forever.

Grantor/Owner, his heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns forever, are hereby divested of any and all abutter's rights, including access rights in, over and to the within described real estate, including such rights with respect to any highway facility constructed thereon (as used herein, the expression "Grantor/Owner" includes the plural, and words in the masculine include the feminine or neuter).
[Surveyor's description of the premises follows]

Situated in the City of Columbus, County of Franklin, State of Ohio and being located in Half Section 27, Township 5 North, Range 22 West of the Refugee Lands, and being part of lands conveyed to City of Columbus, Ohio (hereinafter known as the "Grantor") by Official Record 9097, Pg. C18 of said county records:

Being a parcel of land lying on the right side of the centerline of Road "C" as part of the FRA-70-12.68 Centerline Plat recorded in Plat Book $\qquad$ , Page $\qquad$ of the records of Franklin County and being bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the Grantor's northeast corner, on the west line of a parcel conveyed to Board of Park Commissioners of the Columbus and Franklin County Metropolitan Park District (Inst. No. 200504190072924), and on the south Limited Access right of way line of Interstate 70; (FRA-40R-12.30) Parcel 4-LA conveyed to the State of Ohio by Deed Book 2021, Page 633, said corner being witnessed by a 1 inch iron pipe (bent) found bearing South 09 degrees 17 minutes 03 seconds East, a distance of 0.14 feet; said corner being 125.73 feet right of Sta. 521+42.37 of the centerline of Road "C" and also being the TRUE PLACE OF BEGINNING for the parcel hereinafter described;

THENCE, the following seven (7) courses:

1. South $\mathbf{0 7}$ degrees $\mathbf{3 9}$ minutes $\mathbf{1 3}$ seconds East along the Grantor's east line and west line of said Board of Park Commissioners parcel, a distance of $\mathbf{1 0 4 . 8 1}$ feet to an angle point in said line, said angle point being witnessed by a 1 inch iron pipe (bent) found bearing South 71 degrees 27
minutes 43 seconds West, a distance of 0.15 feet, said angle point also being 230.48 feet right of Sta. $521+38.45$ of the centerline of Road " C ";
2. South $\mathbf{8 2}$ degrees $\mathbf{3 6}$ minutes $\mathbf{1 6}$ seconds West, a distance of $\mathbf{9 8 . 6 0}$ feet to a $5 / 8$ inch by 30 inch rebar with cap "GPD" set, being 224.02 feet right of Sta. $520+27.84$ of the centerline of Road "C";
3. South $\mathbf{7 9}$ degrees $\mathbf{3 7}$ minutes $\mathbf{3 5}$ seconds West, a distance of $\mathbf{8 9 . 6 4}$ feet to a $5 / 8$ inch by 30 inch rebar with cap "GPD" set, being 217.89 feet right of Sta. 519+26.70 of the centerline of Road "C";
4. North $\mathbf{6 3}$ degrees $\mathbf{0 9}$ minutes $\mathbf{5 6}$ seconds West, a distance of $\mathbf{8 1 . 4 4}$ feet to a $5 / 8$ inch by 30 inch rebar with cap "GPD" set, being 161.70 feet right of Sta. $518+61.25$ of the centerline of Road "C";
5. Southwesterly, an arc distance of $\mathbf{1 9 7 . 8 8}$ feet, on a curve deflecting to the left, having a central angle of $\mathbf{0 3}$ degrees $\mathbf{5 9}$ minutes $\mathbf{5 0}$ seconds, radius of $\mathbf{2 8 3 6} .25$ feet and a chord that bears South 69 degrees 49 minutes 08 seconds West, a distance of 197.84 feet to a $5 / 8$ inch by 30 inch rebar with cap "GPD" set on the south Limited Access right of way line of Interstate 70, the southerly line of said Parcel 4LA and the Grantor's westerly line, said rebar set being 161.55 feet right of Sta. $516+52.12$ of the centerline of Road "C";
6. North $\mathbf{3 1}$ degrees $\mathbf{3 2}$ minutes $\mathbf{0 6}$ seconds East along said limited access line, a distance of $\mathbf{6 8 . 3 3}$ feet to the northwest corner of the Grantor's parcel and an angle point in the southerly line of said Parcel 4LA, said corner being 120.48 feet right of Sta. $517+08.07$ of the centerline of Road "C";
7. North $\mathbf{7 4}$ degrees $\mathbf{5 8}$ minutes $\mathbf{1 0}$ seconds East along said limited access line, the southerly line of said Parcel 4LA and the Grantor's north line, a distance of $\mathbf{4 0 8 . 5 9}$ feet to the TRUE PLACE OF BEGINNING.

The above described tract contains 0.6323 acres, including 0.0000 acres in the present road occupied (PRO), more or less, and subject to all easements, restrictions and covenants of record.
