The goal of this project is to replace the existing 4-inch, 6-inch and 8-inch water lines that have a high break frequency. Replacement of these lines will improve water service, decrease burden on water maintenance operations, and reduce water loss.

Work consists of open-cut installation of approximately 592 linear feet of 6-inch water main, 10,163 linear feet of 8-inch water main, and other such work as may be necessary to complete the contract.

Planning Areas: "63 – South Side" planning area and includes the following streets: Southwood Avenue, Hanford Street, Bruck Street, Frebis Avenue, E.
