Sir,

The following investigation was conducted concerning the City of Columbus' 2019 annual objection to the renewal of liquor permit **7640081** issued to **S EMAN INC**, which is doing business as **Convenient Plus Food Mart** located at **1541 Frebis Ave., Columbus, Ohio 43206**. The recorded owner of said permit is **Zubeeda Khanam**.

After reviewing the State of Ohio, Franklin County, and City of Columbus records regarding the above liquor permit establishment, the following information has been compiled to support the objection to the renewal of the aforementioned permit issued by the State of Ohio.

The above listed liquor establishment has been issued a **C1** and **C2** permits by the Division of Liquor. This permit grants the permit holder the privilege to sell alcoholic beverages at the above listed address.

An inquiry of liquor violations revealed that the permit holder has received the following violations in **2019**:

In addition, the Columbus Division of Police have been dispatched to **1541 Frebis Ave., Columbus Ohio 43206** on **(39) thirty-nine** calls for service, **(17) seventeen** in 2018, and **(22) twenty-two** in 2019 at **Convenient Plus Food Mart**.

A review of the Columbus Division of Fire records revealed that there have been **(7) seven** overdoses in **2019** at **Convenient Plus Food Mart**.
