Sir,

The following investigation was conducted concerning the City of Columbus' 2019 annual objection to the renewal of liquor permit 5277278 issued to **LONG STREET NIGHTLIFE LLC**, which is doing business as **XO Nightclub** located at **40-50 E. Long St. & 43 Lafayette St., Columbus, Ohio 43215**. The recorded owners of said permit are **Chris Corso** and **Mike Gallacchio**.

After reviewing the State of Ohio, Franklin County, and City of Columbus records regarding the above liquor permit establishment, the following information has been compiled to support the objection to the renewal of the aforementioned permit issued by the State of Ohio.

The above listed liquor establishment has been issued a **D1**, **D2**, **D3**, **D3A**, and **D6** permits by the Division of Liquor. This permit grants the permit holder the privilege to sell alcoholic beverages at the above listed address.

An inquiry of liquor violations revealed that the permit holder has received the following violations in **2019**:

## February 16, 2018

DEPARTMENT OF TAXATION DO NO PROCEED LETTER ISSUED - still active

## November 15, 2019

INSANITARY CONDITIONS – ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES NOT MAINTAINED IN POTABLE CONDITION

## November 16, 2019

OUTSTANDING TAX ISSUE - still active

A review of the Columbus Division of Police records revealed the Division of Police has created **(34) thirty-four** official police reports concerning incidents at the listed liquor establishment between **January 2018** and **November 2019**. These reports referenced felonious assault, robbery, weapons offenses, domestic violence, theft, simple assault, criminal damaging, and drug overdoses.

September 8, 2019 ROBBERY

October 6, 2019 SHOOTING

In addition, the Columbus Division of Police have been dispatched to **40-50 E. Long St. & 43 Lafayette St., Columbus, Ohio 43215** on **(46) forty-six** calls for service, **(16) sixteen** in 2018, and **(30) thirty** in 2019 at **XO Nightclub**.

A review of the Columbus Division of Fire records revealed that there have been **(14) fourteen** overdoses in **2019** at **XO Nightclub**.
