The City utilizes ground yard waste, whole tree woodchips, sawdust, straw, logs, and ground wood waste as bulking agents to process sewage sludge. The services are to provide equipment and an operator for grinding yard waste and wood waste, sizing and grinding logs.

This is a continuation of services of the existing contract for services to grind yard waste, wood waste and sizing and grinding of logs to use as a bulking agent to process sewage sludge into Com-Til.
