This project will provide sewer rehabilitation, replacement sewers, water quality improvements and pump station upgrades as necessary to rehabilitate sewer infrastructure in East Franklinton and provide for redevelopment of the area.

This project serves the 54 - Franklinton area and includes the following streets: W. Broad Street, W. Gay Street, Scott Street, and N. Mill Street.

Contract work is required to be completed in a manner acceptable to the City within 300 calendar for substantial completion and 365 calendar days for final completion from the Notice to Proceed (NTP).

This project will address consent order obligations to the Ohio EPA in the Dodge Park Combined Sewer Overflow area. Project will also facilitate redevelopment of Columbus's oldest neighborhood, Franklinton. The tremendous economic and social benefits to the area have been previously estimated and presented in a report "East Franklinton Creative Community District Plan".

The bid amount and proposed award amount is \$3,447,682.50 including a 25% construction contingency amount that will be utilized to fund needed and approved changes in the work.
