Requests for proposals were taken again in 2015 and eight vendors responded. A group of five CRPD staff evaluated the proposals and Activenet was selected to continue as the provider.				
The department is requesting to waive the competitive bidding provisions of the Columbus City Code Chapter 329 due to the complex nature of the service; a public-facing registration interface also used for internal accounting, auditing, organizational and safety measures. Switching to a new provider would be a complex process requiring a tremendous amount of time and planning in order to consider other service providers and to make a smooth transition. The Recreation and Parks Department has been very satisfied with the Activenet registration system and does not have a compelling reason to consider other registration systems at this time.
