Work consists of removal of existing coatings and application of a new coating system (exterior, interior wet ceiling and interior dry area) on a two (2) million gallon fluted column steel elevated water storage tank, and other such work as may be necessary to complete the contract, in accordance with the technical specifications, and City of Columbus Construction and Material Specifications as set forth in the Invitation For Bid (IFB).

Community planning area: 31 – Far Northwest

Contract work is required to be completed in a manner acceptable to the City within 150 days from the date that a Notice To Proceed (NTP) is given by the City. The City anticipates issuing a Notice to Proceed on or about May 2020.

There are currently 37 water tanks in the distribution system and 25 of them are maintained by the City of Columbus, Division of Water. To keep these tanks in optimal condition, each year tank interiors or exteriors are identified to be recoated.

The Summitview tank exterior requires a new coating system. Interior dry area work including dry riser tube and fill pipe is needed. Roof venting will be upgraded to frost free type and various safety improvements will be made to ladders, platforms, and lighting. Anchor lugs will be also installed on roof for fall protection.

8. An estimate of the full cost of the Contract including a separate estimate of any and all phases or proposed future contract modifications.

The bid amount and proposed award amount is \$1,493,160.00, including a 15% construction contingency amount that will be utilized to fund needed and approved changes in the work. No contract modifications are anticipated at this time; however, construction exigency might later compel modification of this contract, if unforeseen difficulties are encountered.
