Here is the response that I received from Sonia Krammes (IT) and Mike Edwards (GIS) regarding cost effectiveness for this project. Please let me know if this is satisfactory.

In my professional opinion the OSIP III contract is the most cost-effective method to obtain the high-level spatial accuracy and resolution DPU has come to expect. I recall having a similar conversation with Purchasing and Dave before the 2019 flight. Woolpert knows we don't have to use the OSIP contract and in return provides us a fair price for their services in my opinion.

Other cities and counties contract with Woolpert directly and their resulting costs per square mile are comparable but will also include administrative fees. We pay a flat fee under the State contract. Some area counties have contracted directly with other vendors with mixed results -- namely image quality and pixel accuracy that would not meet our needs. The time to write and administer our own RFP could also be considered an added internal cost if we went that route.
