	Street Maintenance is requesting a bid waiver for the 3-wheel sweepers, as there was only the one vendor that submitted a bid on the 3 Wheel Sweepers. A bid waiver is required when a vendor does not meet all o the specifications.
	This vendor's bid has the sweeper's main broom at 66 inches long compared to the bid requiring the sweeper's main broom to be a minimum of 68 inches long, which is a 2-inch difference. After discussions with Street Maintenance, they are fine with the vendor's bid. Street Maintenance does not see or feel that the 2-inch difference in the length of the main broom will not have an effect on the operation of the Street Sweeping Program, as the vendor's bid for the overall sweeping width meets bid and is the same overall sweeping width of current 3 Wheel Sweepers.

The City received two bids for the 3-wheel street sweepers on May 28, 2020, and they were tabulated as follows:

## 5. If lowest bid was not accepted, explain criteria for award:

The lowest bid (The Safety Company) was deemed unresponsive due to the bidder's not submitting the required documents. The second-lowest bid (Jack Doheny Companies, Inc.) met all of the specifications for the 3-wheel street sweepers except one section. Jack Doheny Companies, Inc. bid has the sweeper's main broom at 66 inches long compared to the bid requiring the sweeper's main broom to be a minimum of 68 inches long, which is a 2-inch difference. The 2-inch difference in the length of the main broom will not affect the operation of the Street Sweeping Program, as the vendor's bid for the overall sweeping width meets bid and is the same overall sweeping width of current 3-wheel sweepers.
