The following investigation was conducted concerning the City of Columbus' 2019 annual objection to the renewal of liquor permit **5389275** issued to **M &M Market & Carryout LLC**, which is doing business as **M & M Market & Carryout** located at **1596 Oakland Park Avenue, Columbus, Ohio 43224**. The recorded owner of said permit is **Asia Khan**.

After reviewing the State of Ohio, Franklin County, and City of Columbus records regarding the above liquor permit establishment, the following information has been compiled to support the objection to the renewal of the aforementioned permit issued by the State of Ohio.

The above listed liquor establishment has been issued a **C1 and C2** permits by the Division of Liquor. This permit grants the permit holder the privilege to sell alcoholic beverages at the above listed address.

A review of the Columbus Division of Police records revealed the Division of Police has created **(12) twelve** official police reports concerning incidents at the listed liquor establishment between **January 2019** and **November 2020**. These reports referenced shooting, robbery, assaults, drug trafficking, illegal tobacco sales, intoxicated persons needing assistance, and motor vehicle theft, including:

In addition, the Columbus Division of Police have been dispatched to **1596 Oakland Park Avenue**, Columbus Ohio 43224 on (20) twenty calls for service, (15) fifteen in 2019, and (5) five in 2020 at M&M. These calls for service include responses to robberies, persons needing medical assistance, fights and disturbances, assaults, and narcotics complaints.
