## RAKEFORD DR & CRICKET PL 148169 1-WD4 RIGHT-OF-WAY CRICKET PLACE DESCRIPTION OF 0.008 ACRES

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin, City of Columbus being located in North Half of Section 9, Quarter Township 3, Township 2, Range 17, of the United States Military Lands and being a part of the 1.620 acres Open Space as shown and delineated upon a plat titled "The Commons at Parkridge" of record in record Plat Book 57, Page 110 and described in a deed to Parkridge Commons Association by deed of record in Official Record Book 2385C14. All references to records herein are those located in the Recorder's Office of Franklin County, Ohio and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a mag nail set in the centerline intersection of Rakeford Drive (29' width) with the centerline of Cricket Place (29' width);

Thence S 11 degrees 20 minutes 35 seconds E a distance of 28.56 feet with the centerline of Cricket Place to a point;

Thence S 78 degrees 39 minutes 25 seconds W a distance of 15.50 feet across Cricket Place roadway to an iron pin set in the existing westerly right of way line, same being the northeasterly line of said 1.620 acres Open Space and being the *TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING*;

Thence S 70 degrees 41 minutes 17 seconds W a distance of 26.35 feet across said 1.620 acres Open Space to an iron pin set;

Thence N 11 degrees 20 minutes 35 seconds W a distance of 17.70 feet across said 1.620 acres Open Space to an iron pin set in the existing southerly right of way line of Rakeford Drive, also being the northerly line of said 1.620 acres Open Space;

Thence N 78 degrees 39 minutes 25 seconds E a distance of 7.00 feet with the existing southerly right of way line of Rakeford Drive and the northerly line of said 1.620 acres Open Space to an iron pin set at a point of curvature;

Thence on the arc of a curve to the right with the existing southerly right of way line of Rakeford Drive and the northeasterly line of said 1.620 acres Open Space and the existing westerly right of way line of Cricket Place, having as its elements a delta of 72°40'58", a radius of 20.00 feet, an arc length of 25.37 feet with a **Chord Bearing of S65°00'06"E with a Chord length of 23.70 feet** to the end of said curve and the **TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING**; containing 0.008 acres of land, more or less.

The above described area contains a total of **0.008 acres** within Franklin County Auditor's Parcel Number 600-187079-00, which includes 0.000 acres in the present road occupied and with an overlap of 0.008 acres of a 27 feet wide utility easement as shown and delineated upon the plat titled "The Commons at Parkridge" of record in record Plat Book 57, Page 110.

Grantor claims title by Instrument recorded in Official Record Book 2385C14 in the records of Franklin County, Ohio.

Iron pins set, as shown on plan and in the above description are 5/8 inch steel rod, thirty (30) inches long with a plastic cap stamped "Rii".

Mag nail set, as shown on plan and in above description are magnetically enhanced nails (zinc plated) two and one half (2-1/2) in length by one quarter inch (1/4) head
