

### **Site Information**

- The 5.633± acre site is a fringe-type municipal annexation.
- The property is owned by the City of Columbus and involves roadway in Hayden Run Boulevard at the intersection of Avery Road, extending west approximately 1,370 feet to the CSX railroad.
- The site requires a boundary conformance.

#### **Key Issues**

- Annexation will bring the newly constructed roadway into the Columbus corporate boundary.
- The annexation agreement between the City and Washington Township requires the City to conform the boundaries of Montgomery Township to make them identical to the corporate limits of the City of Columbus for this site. A separate ordinance will be submitted upon approval by the Board of Franklin County Commissioners, authorizing acceptance of the annexation and subsequent boundary conformance.

# **Legislative Information**

- Planning staff are processing the annexation application in coordination with Public Service staff. This ordinance authorizes the
  Department of Public Service Director to file a Type 1 annexation petition on behalf of the City of Columbus with the Franklin
  County Board of Commissioners.
- After the petition is filed, the commissioners have 30 days to take action.
