The overall agreement will provide professional engineering services during construction for the Hap Cremean Water Plant (HCWP) Concrete Rehabilitation Project, CIP No. 690389-

100001, Contract No. 2247 (aka Phase 2).

Professional engineering services will be divided into five steps as follows:

Step 1 - Condition Assessment & Preliminary Design (initial agreement, PO019838)

Step 2 - Detailed Design for Phase 1 (Renewal 1, PO133389-1)

Step 3 – Engineering Services During Construction for Phase 1 (Renewal 2, PO182088)

Step 4 – Engineering Services During Construction for Phase 2 (this renewal)

Step 5 – Engineering Services During Construction for Phase 2 continued (to be authorized under future renewal 4)

Work to be performed under this renewal is for Engineering Services During Construction of Phase 2 improvements (step 3 services).

Planning Area = "99 – Citywide" since the HCWP serves multiple planning areas.

This project will rehabilitate deteriorated concrete around the treatment basins at the Divisions' largest water treatment plant to prevent further and more costly damage that could occur if rehabilitation was postponed and to extend the life of this asset. This project is part of the City's ongoing efforts to maintain a reliable supply of safe drinking water to its customers, which will result in sustainable economic growth well into the future.

Public informational meetings are not anticipated for this project. All proposed work is anticipated to occur within the boundaries of the Hap Cremean Water Plant.

- Initial contract <u>PO019838</u>: field condition assessment of the HCWP concrete setting basins.
- Renewal 1, <u>PO0133389</u> detailed design and preparation of construction bid documents for phase 1 of 2. Based on information collected during step 1, and after review of 2018 three-year outlook schedule for the plant outages and distribution system water demands, it was determined to be necessary to divide the improvements across two construction contracts (Phase 1 and 2). This renewal included design services for both phases.
- Renewal 2, <u>PO182088</u> Provided engineering service during Construction for Phase 1.

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- 9. <u>A full description of the work to be performed as part of the proposed contract renewal.</u> (Indicating the work to be a logical extension of the contract is not sufficient explanation.) This planned renewal provides funding for engineering services during construction for the phase 2 bid package, including but not limited to shop drawing review services, responding to RFIs, preparing RFPs and reviewing subsequent proposals, attending construction progress meetings, periodic site visits, and preparation of record documents.

Engineering services during construction were included in the original RFP advertisement for which the Division received proposals on November 2015 from interested firms. The current consultant has gained detailed knowledge of the condition of the structures that is essential for completing the detailed design and construction. Bidding this work out to a new consultant would require duplication of some of the condition assessment and detail design work already performed, increasing project costs and extending the project schedule.
