Dear Mayor Ginther:

The Columbus Public Health Department is requesting authority to enter into a contract with Giant Eagle for the purpose of obtaining gift cards, which will be provided to the community as an incentive to receive a Covid-19 vaccine. Columbus Public Health is currently implementing a community vaccine outreach and incentive program to promote adoption of such vaccines in our neighborhoods. These vaccines are needed to mitigate the spread of the pandemic and thus far community response has been overwhelming. The strength of the community adoption has exceeded expectations and as such additional funds are needed in order to ensure that this program can continue without interruption. Ordinance 0821-2021 is currently being considered by City Council and will appear on the July 12, 2021 agenda. This ordinance authorizes the expenditure of \$350,000,00 for the purpose of expanding the vaccine incentive program. However, pursuant to passage, there will be an interim time period where this ordinance is certified and the City Auditor makes funds available. It is expected that the existing vaccine incentive program will exhaust current funding prior to these legislated funds being available for use.

Therefore, Columbus Public Health is requesting authority to execute a purchase order(s), with Giant Eagle, in order to continue the COVID-19 Vaccine Incentive Program. Funding will be provided by the American Rescue Plan Recovery Fund. This Mayor's Emergency Letter hereby authorizes the expenditure of the following:

The Columbus Public Health Department is requesting authority to enter into a contract with Giant Eagle for the purpose of obtaining gift cards, which will be provided to the community as an incentive to receive a Covid-19 vaccine. Columbus Public Health is currently implementing a community vaccine outreach and incentive program to promote adoption of such vaccines in our neighborhoods. These vaccines are needed to mitigate the spread of the pandemic and thus far community response has been overwhelming. The strength of the community adoption has exceeded expectations and as such additional funds are needed in order to ensure that this program can continue without interruption. The Ohio Department of Health Coronavirus Response Supplemental Grant program will fund the purchase of the additional gift cards.

Ordinance 2123-2021 will authorize the transfer and expenditure of \$434,676 from Object Class 01 (personnel) to Object Class 03 (services), however there will be an interim time period where this ordinance is reviewed by Council and certified so that the City Auditor can make funds available. It is expected that the existing vaccine incentive program will exhaust current funding prior to these legislated funds being available for use.

Therefore, Columbus Public Health is requesting authority to execute a purchase order(s), with Giant Eagle and to transfer funds within the Coronavirus Response Supplemental Grant program, in order to continue the COVID-19 Vaccine Incentive Program.
