The following investigation was conducted concerning the City of Columbus' 2021 annual objection to the renewal of liquor permit **46213250005** issued to **Khurram LLC**, which is doing business as **Mobile Mart** located at **830 Parsons Avenue, Columbus, Ohio 43206**. The recorded owners of said permit are **Khurram Shahzad** and **Naqash Ahmed**.

The City of Columbus also objected to the renewal of this permit in November 2020. The Ohio Department of Commerce Division of Liquor Control has not yet held a final hearing on that objection.

After reviewing the State of Ohio, Franklin County, and City of Columbus records regarding the above liquor permit establishment, the following information has been compiled to support the objection to the renewal of the aforementioned permit issued by the State of Ohio.

The above listed liquor establishment has been issued **C1 and C2** permits by the Division of Liquor. This permit grants the permit holder the privilege to sell alcoholic beverages at the above listed address.

A review of the Columbus Division of Police records revealed the Division of Police has created **(12) twelve** official police reports concerning incidents at the listed liquor establishment between **January 2020** and **November 2021**. These reports referenced homicide, robberies, assaults, recovered firearms, drug offenses, assaults, motor vehicle thefts, and intoxicated individuals needing assistance, including:

In addition, the Columbus Division of Police have been dispatched to **830** Parsons Avenue, Columbus, Ohio 43206 on (35) thirty-one calls for service, (19) nineteen in 2020, and (17) seventeen in 2021 at Mobile Mart. These calls for service include responses to a persona with a gun or knife, shots fired, robbery, assaults, sexual assault, overdoses, intoxicated persons needing assistance, fights and disturbances, and motor vehicle theft complaints.
