The following is a resolution to declare the necessity and intent to appropriate fee simple title and lesser interests in and to real estate in connection with the Arterial Street Rehabilitation - North High Street Flint to County Line Project.

Emergency Justification:

Emergency action is requested to allow the acquisition of the parcels necessary for this project to proceed as not to delay the commencement of the construction necessary to the project.

To declare the necessity and intent to appropriate fee simple title and lesser interests in and to real estate in connection with the Arterial Street Rehabilitation - North High Street Flint to County Line Project, and to declare an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City of Columbus is engaged in the Arterial Street Rehabilitation - North High Street Flint to County Line Project; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in the usual daily operation of the Department of Public Service, Division of Design and Construction, in that it is immediately necessary to declare the necessity and intent to appropriate fee simple title and lesser interests in and to the hereinbefore described real estate necessary for the aforementioned project so that there will be no delay in the project thereby preserving the public health, peace, property, safety, and welfare; now, therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS:

Section 1. That this Council hereby declares the necessity and intent to appropriate fee simple title and lesser interests in and to the following listed parcels of real estate more fully described in Exhibits A through S attached hereto and made a part hereof as though fully written herein, necessary for the Arterial Street Rehabilitation - North High Street Flint to County Line Project, Project #530161 pursuant to and in accordance with the Charter of the City of Columbus, Columbus City Code (1959) Revised, Chapter 909, the Constitution of the State of Ohio and Ohio Revised Code, Chapter 719; to-wit:
