To accept the amounts and rates by the Franklin County Budget Commission for the City's Tax Budget for 2004 and to declare an emergency.

This action is required as part of the County tax budget process. This resolution accepts the amounts and rates determined by the Franklin County Budget Commission and authorizes the necessary tax levies.

Whereas, this Council, in accordance with the provisions of law, has previously adopted a tax budget for the fiscal year commencing January 1, 2004; and

Whereas, the Budget Commission of Franklin County, Ohio, has certified its action to this Council together with an estimate by the County Auditor of the rate of each tax necessary to be levied by the Council, and what part thereof is without and what part is within the ten mill limitation; and

Whereas, an emergency exists in the usual daily operation of the City Government in that it is immediately necessary to accept the amounts and rates fixed by the County Budget Commission for the City's tax budget for the year 2004 for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, property and safety; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS:

Section 1. That the amounts and rates as determined by the Franklin County Budget Commission in its certification, be and the same are hereby accepted.

Section 2. Be it further resolved that there be and is hereby levied on the tax duplicate of said City the rates of each tax necessary to be levied within and without the ten mill limitation, as set forth in SCHEDULE A, as follows:
