

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS, OHIO (“CITY”):

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the City’s Charter, Columbus City Revised Code, Chapter 909 (1959), Constitution of the state of Ohio, and Ohio Revised Code, Chapter 719, this Council declares the necessity and intent of the City to appropriate fee simple title and lesser interests to the following listed parcels of real estate (“Property”), which are fully described in their associated exhibits; fully incorporated into this resolution; and necessary for the City’s Department of Public Service, Division of Design and Construction, Traffic Signal Installation - Neil Avenue Signals (2945 Dr E/PID 540007-100029):

SECTION 3. That for the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which are made a part hereof, this resolution is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, or ten days after its passage if the Mayor neither approves nor vetoes this resolution.
