BACKGROUND: The Columbus Health Department has been awarded additional grant funds from the Ohio Department of Health to fund the Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) Program in the amount of \$100,112, for a total grant award in the amount of \$4,484,773. The additional funding will allow the program to continue to offer the services being provided. The purpose of this legislation is to accept and appropriate these funds to conduct the WIC Program for the period October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007.

The primary objective of the Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) Program is to provide nutritionally desirable food and nutrition education to pregnant and lactating women, infants, and children at nutritional risk in Franklin County who meet categorical, income

and nutritional risk requirements for eligibility.

Emergency action is requested in order to avoid any delays in providing program services.

FISCAL IMPACT: The Women, Infants and Children Program is entirely funded by the Ohio Department of Health. This program does not generate any revenue or require a City match.

To authorize and direct the Columbus Health Department to accept grant funds from the Ohio Department of Health in the amount of \$100,112; to authorize the appropriation of \$100,112 from the Health Department Grants Fund; and to declare an emergency, (\$100,112)

WHEREAS, \$100,112 in additional grant funds have been made available through the Ohio Department of Health for the Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) grant program for the period October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary to accept and appropriate these funds from the Ohio Department of Health for the continued support of the WIC Program; and,

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in the usual daily operation of the Health Department in that it is immediately necessary to accept these grant funds from the Ohio Department of Health and to appropriate these funds to the Health Department for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, property, safety and welfare; Now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS:

SECTION 1. That the Columbus Health Department is hereby authorized and directed to accept additional grant awards totaling \$100,112 from the Ohio Department of Health for the Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) grant program for the period October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007.

SECTION 2. That from the unappropriated monies in the fund known as Health Department Grants Fund, Fund No. 251, and from all monies estimated to come into said fund from any and all sources and unappropriated for any other purpose during the twelve months ending December 31, 2007, the sum of \$100,112 is hereby appropriated to the Department of Health, Department No. 50-01, as follows:

OCA: 506016; Grant: 506016; Object Level 1: 01; Amount: \$73,320

OCA: 506016; Grant: 506016; Object Level 1: 02; Amount: \$16,792

OCA: 506016; Grant: 506016; Object Level 1: 03; Amount: \$10,000

SECTION 3. That the monies appropriated in the foregoing Section 2 shall be paid upon the order of the Health Commissioner and that no order shall be drawn or money paid except upon voucher, the form of which shall be approved by the City Auditor.

SECTION 4. That for reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, or ten days after passage if the Mayor neither approves nor vetoes the same.
