..Explanation

**BACKGROUND:** This legislation authorizes the Finance and Management Director to establish a Universal Term Contract (UTC) for the option to purchase Road and Sewer Maintenance Equipment Parts and Services with The McLean Company. The Division of Fleet Management is the primary user for Road and Sewer Maintenance Equipment Parts and Services, used to repair and maintain City vehicles. The McLean Company is the sole source for these parts and services as they are the only local distributor and authorized service provider for Wirtgen Group (Wirtgen, Hamm, Voge, Kleeman), Leeboy, Rosco, Bagela Asphalt Recyclers, Cimline Rubberized Crack Sealers, Falcon Hot Boxes, Stewart Amos Street Sweepers, and Super Products Sewer Truck Vacuum and Jetters. The term of the proposed option contract would be approximately three (3) years, expiring August 31, 2024, with the option to renew for one (1) additional year. In addition, the expenditure of \$1.00 is hereby authorized from General Budget Reservation BRPO001670.

To authorize the Finance and Management Director to enter into a Universal Term Contract for the option to purchase Road and Sewer Maintenance Equipment Parts and Services with The McLean Company in accordance with the sole source provisions of the Columbus City Code; and to authorize the expenditure of \$1.00 from General Budget Reservation BRPO001670. (\$1.00).

**WHEREAS**, the Road and Sewer Maintenance Equipment Parts and Services UTC will provide for the purchase of Road and Sewer Maintenance Equipment Parts and Services used to repair City vehicles and The McLean Company is the sole source provider of these goods and services; and,

**WHEREAS**, it has become necessary in the daily operation of the Department of Finance and Management, Division of Fleet Management, to authorize the Finance and Management Director to enter into a Universal Term Contract for the option to purchase Road and Sewer Maintenance Equipment Parts and Services with The McLean Company; **now, therefore**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Finance and Management Director is hereby authorized to enter into the following Universal Term Contract for the option to purchase Road and Sewer Maintenance Equipment Parts and Services for a term of approximately three (3) years, expiring August 31, 2024, with the option to renew for one (1) additional year, as follows:

The McLean Company, \$1.00

**SECTION 2.** That the expenditure of \$1.00 is hereby authorized from General Budget Reservation BRPO001670 of this ordinance to pay the cost thereof.

**SECTION 3.** That this purchase is in accordance with relevant provisions of the Columbus City Code, "Sole Source Procurement."

**SECTION 4.** That the funds necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance are hereby deemed appropriated, and the City Auditor shall establish such accounting codes as necessary.

**SECTION 5.** That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
