BACKGROUND: This legislation authorizes the Finance and Management Director to associate all General Budget reservations resulting from this ordinance with the following Universal Term Contract Purchase Agreements listed below for the purchase of DO Probes for the Division of Sewerage and Drainage, Jackson Pike Wastewater Treatment Plant. These parts will replace the existing DO probes, which are 15 years old, and obsolete. The probes are used to measure the dissolved oxygen level in our aeration tanks, which is a vital part of the treatment process. Installation will be performed by City employees.

To authorize the Finance and Management Director to associate all General Budget Reservations resulting from this ordinance with the appropriate Universal Term Contract Purchase Agreements for the purchase of DO Probes for the Division of Sewerage and Drainage; and to authorize the expenditure of \$240,000.00 from the Sewerage Operating Fund. (\$240,000.00)

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Office has established Universal Term Contract Purchase Agreements for the purchase of DO Probes; and

WHEREAS, these parts will replace the existing DO probes. The probes are used to measure the dissolved oxygen level in our aeration tanks at the Jackson Pike Wastewater Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary in the usual daily operation of the Department of Public Utilities to authorize the Finance and Management Director to associate all General Budget Reservations resulting from this ordinance with the appropriate Universal Term Contract Purchase Agreements for the purchase of DO Probes; thereby preserving the public health, peace, property, safety, and welfare; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS:

SECTION 1. That the Finance and Management Director be and is hereby authorized to associate all General Budget

Reservations resulting from this ordinance with the appropriate Universal Term Contract Purchase Agreements for the purchase of DO Probes for the Division of Sewerage and Drainage.

SECTION 2. That the funds necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance are hereby deemed appropriated, and the City Auditor shall establish such accounting codes as necessary.

SECTION 3. That the expenditure of \$240,000.00 or so much thereof as may be needed, be and is hereby authorized in Fund 6100 Sewer Operating Sanitary Fund; in object class 02 Materials and Supplies per the accounting codes in the attachment to this ordinance.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
