This ordinance amends the Police Management Compensation Plan, Ordinance 2715-2013, as amended, by: Amending insurance provisions and language in Section 8.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the Police Management Compensation Plan by amending Section 8, Insurances; and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in the usual daily operation of the City in that it is immediately necessary to amend certain provisions of the Police Management Compensation Plan, thereby preserving the public peace, property, health, safety, and welfare; Now, Therefore

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS:

Section 1. That the Police Management Compensation Plan, Ordinance No. 2715-2013, as amended, is hereby amended as follows:
